DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1 Root must be cleaned using Shingle Shield Roof & Deck Cleaner prior to the installation of Shingle Shield zinc strips.
- 2 Beginning from either end of the roof peak install a continuous single row under the first available course of shingles below the ridge head. Note: A dab of roofing cement over the nail high quality hot-dipped galvanized roofing nail. Note: A dab of roofing cement over the nail pre-punched hole and nail into place using a 1/4" (0.3 centimeters) gap between each section. Allow for thermal expansion and contraction, or just overlap them slightly.
- 3 Simply slide one Shingle Shield up under the shingle until its built-in alignment guide butts against the edge of the shingle.
- 4 Once aligned, raise shingle tab, locate the midway down the roof slope.
- 5 Repeat this process along the roof line until the row is completed. Note: For persistent problems, cover condition, or shingles greater than 20 ft, install a second row midway down the roof slope.
- 6 Additional Shingle Shield pieces should be placed below corners, chimneys, or any other obstruction which blocks the flow of rainwater from the ridge line.

Do not reuse empty container. Wipe container and place in trash.

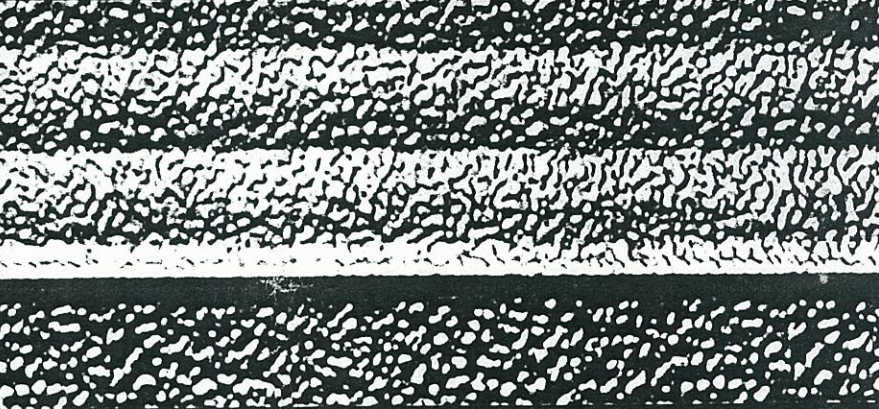

Almacenamiento y desecho

No use los recipientes vacios nuevamente. Envuelva el recipiente y coluquela en la basura.

- 3 Simplemente deslice una teja Shingle hasta Shield™ hasta que su guia de alineacion integrada quede junto a la orilla de la teja.
- 4 Una vez que este alineada, suba la pestaña de la teja, encuentre el orificio perforado previamente y clavela en su lugar usando un clavo para techos galvanizado y templado de alta calidad. Nota: Poner un poquito de cemento para techos sobre la cabeza del clavo asegurara que la teja soale a prueba de agua (en caso de tratarse de un techo de madera, use un clavo de cabeza con arandela de neopreno).
- 5 Repita este proceso por toda la linea imaginaria del techo hasta completar la hilera. Nota: En el caso de problemas persistentes, condiciones severas o inclinaciones de mas de 20 pies, instale una segunda hilera a mediados del declive del techo.
- 6 Se pueden colocar tejas Shingle Shield™ adicionales debajo de buhardillas, chimeneas o cualquier otra obstruccion que bloquee el flujo del agua de la lluvia desde el caballete del techo.

INSTRUCCIONES DE USO

- 1 Hay que limpiar el techo usando el limpiador de techos y cubiertas de madera Shingle Shield™ antes de instalar las tiras de zinc Shingle Shield™.
- 2 Empezar desde cualquier extremo de la parte mas alta del techo para instalar una hilera sencilla continua bajo la primera hilera de tejas debajo de la linea del caballete. Deje una distancia de 1.8 de pulgada (0.3 cm) entre cada seccion para permitir que haya una expansion termica, o simplemente traslapelas ligeramente.

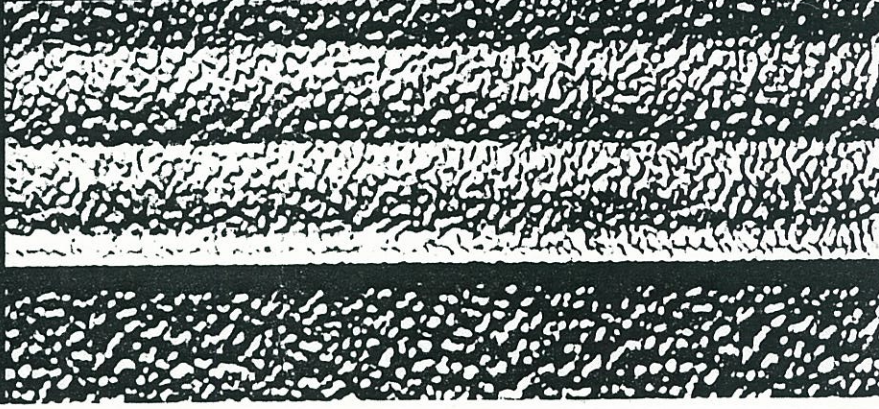

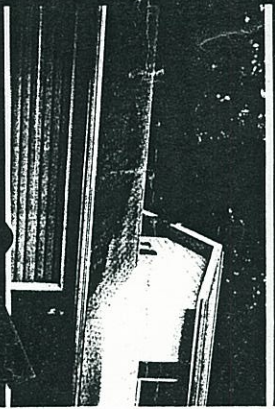

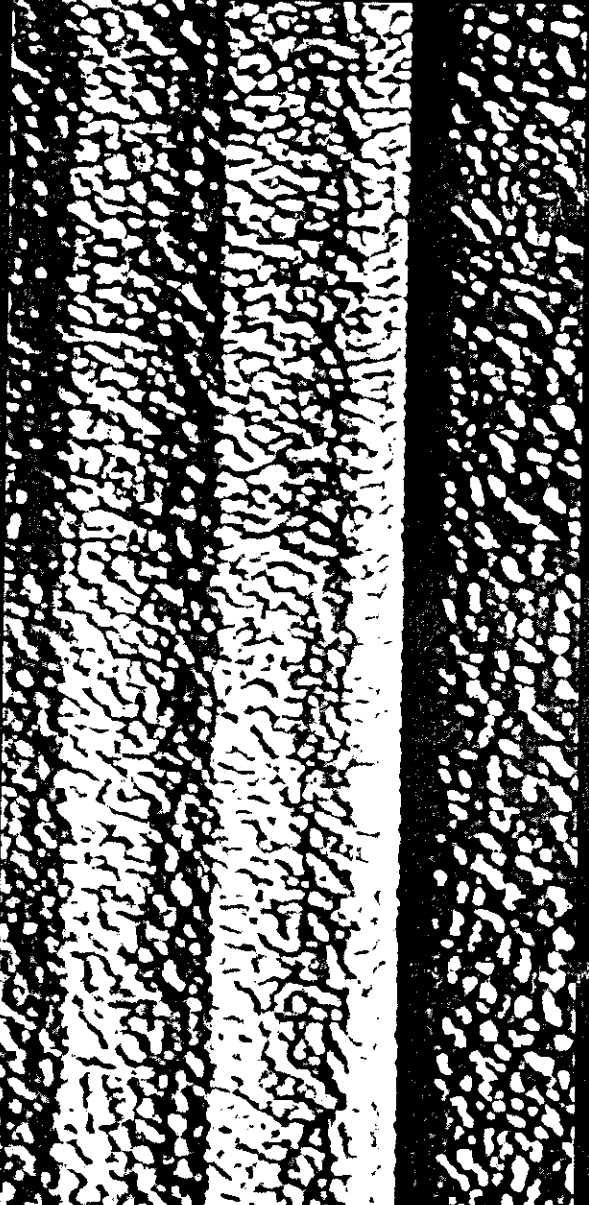

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1 Roof must be cleaned using Shingle Shield Roof & Deck Cleaner prior to the installation of Shingle Shield zinc strips.
- 2 Beginning from either end of the roof peak install a continuous single row under the first available course of shingles below the ridge line. To allow for thermal expansion leave a 1/8" (0.3 centimeters) gap between each section, or just overlap them slightly.
- 3 Simply slide one Shingle Shield up under the shingle until its built-in alignment guide butts against the edge of the shingle.
- 4 Once aligned, raise shingle tab, locate the pre-punched hole and nail into place using a high quality hot-dipped galvanized roofing nail. Note: A dab of roofing cement over the nail head will ensure a water-tight seal (wood roofs should use a neoprene washer head nail).
- 5 Repeat this process along the roof line until the row is completed. Note: For persistent problems, severe conditions, or slopes greater than 20 ft., install a second row midway down the roof slope.
- 6 Additional Shingle Shield pieces should be placed below dormers, chimneys, or any other obstruction which blocks the flow of rainwater from the ridge line.
