Howley Rat Bait and House Mouse Bait are ready-to-use, long-lasting bait blocks that are safe for children, pets, non-target mammals, or birds may access the bait.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans And Domestic Animals:
CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Keep away from children, domestic animals and pets. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. All articles (including application) must be kept covered and gloves. Any person who has been exposed or treated with bait, following application of this product must wear gloves.

Use Safety Requirements:
Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning and safety. If no such instructions, do not wash, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash hands thoroughly after applying bait and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet and change into clean clothing.

First Aid:
Have label with you when obtaining treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor or 1-800-234-2269 immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not get anything by mouth in an unconscious person. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Take or be prepared to take: If swallowed, flush with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and flush slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes. Then continue flushing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN:
Contact the manufacturer immediately. This is not an antiparasitic. Not applicable for humans or animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (such as muscle tremors, loss of fine hair, loss of appetite for animals, liver absorption by other animals or aquatic life). Sulfasalicylic acid, if present, would be the result of control agents and should be treated accordingly through administration of an antacid, diluent and cathartic.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is extremely toxic to mammals and birds. Dogs and scavenging mammals and birds will be poisoned if they feed upon a baited rat bait station. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Bait may also be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment, wash water or excess.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ THIS LABEL:** Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions carefully for the sites, pests, and application methods described on this label.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other non-target animals to restrictions. Do not prevent access to bait stations. Bait stations must be placed in a secure location, out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and other non-target animals, or in baited bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be obtained from stations when they are closed, units must be secured, or otherwise tampered with, during bait stations are needed in areas where children, pets, domestic animals, birds or other potentially distressed animals or birds may have access to bait. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled and compromised bait as specified on this label.

Howley Rat Bait and House Mouse Bait are ready-to-use, long-lasting bait blocks that are safe for children, pets, non-target mammals, or birds may access the bait.

USE SITES: This product may only be used to control Howley Rat Bait and House Mouse Bait inside and outside within 50 feet of industrial and agricultural buildings, related port or terminal buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product may also be used in sewers and within 50 feet of surrounding buildings in sewers and for transport vehicles (trucks, trailers, barges) for use in non-food/non-feed areas.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Do not place near or inside ventilation duct openings. Do not contaminate water, food, feed, handling equipment or milk or food handling equipment surfaces that come into direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait. Do not apply within 50 feet from buildings. Do not use this product in individual containers holding less than a pound of bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats and house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rats and house mice or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food accessible to rats as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: The active ingredient in this product is different from other rodenticides. Individual rats and mice cause feeding after consuming a bait dose. For use in sewers, thread wire through block and securely attach to a stationary structure such as the bottom step of a concrete ladder or a sewer grate. Allow just enough wire for the block to rest on marl or sand. If bedding is not present, support block a few inches above the high water mark or secure block on a board supported by opening steps of the ladder. Security block in this manner will help reduce removal by rats or mice. Use one block per structure. Maintain an equal number of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

RATS: Weigh your bait, apply 2 to 12 baits per placement in treated areas. Space placements at intervals of 20 to 30 feet.

HOUSE MICE: Weigh your bait, apply 1 or 2 baits per placement in treated areas. Space placements at intervals of 8 to 12 feet.

FOLLOW-UP: Adjust the amount of bait applied to the level of rat and mouse feeding, especially at each bait placement location. Repeat baiting operation is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, repeat bait placements and refer to bait stations when there is heavy feeding or where there is continued evidence of rat and mouse activity. Maintain bait for at least one year and continue baiting until all signs of rat and mouse activity have ceased or become clear that the remaining bait will not be placed in the bait.

Heavy signs of pest and primary signs of all densities and signs are known to occur after baiting. In the absence of rat and mouse, baiting and burrowing as soon as possible. If infestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and maintain as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from heat.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste material from the use of this product may be disposed of in an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Reusable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse for emptying, then offer for recycling or other reuse or purchase and dispose of the container, or incinerate. In most states, burning is not allowed.
